Does your pet have any history or current issues with vomiting? If yes, how frequently and description (digested food, undigested food, bile, clear, etc.)?

Does your pet have any history or current issues with Sneezing and or coughing? If yes, time of day most often occurs?

How often does your pet have a bowel movement and what is the consistency of it (soft, firm, etc.)?

What color is your pet's urine and how often does he/she urinate?

Does your pet have any urinary or fecal incontinence?

Is your pet restless or fidgety and if so, is there a time of day it is worse, at night or during the day or all the time?

Has there been a change in energy and stamina?

Is your pet startled by loud noises or sudden movements?

Does our pet have a preference for cool or warm places?

How would you describe your pet's general personality: calm, always happy, shy, afraid of strangers, irritable etc.? Any recent behavior changes?

Does your pet have any history of seizures?

Does your pet have any surgical implants?
